EMMA-East 2014: MO Submission

- All applicants are required to submit an MO in their application form. They may propose their own MO, or use a 'public' MO.
- A **public** MO is one of the following:
 - a Bilateral MO (agreed on by an APU and an EPU), or
 - an MO recommended by an EPU/APU but has no specified APU/EPU
- A **private** MO is one proposed by an APU or an EPU, open to revisions/improvements, and can become a public MO later.
- The only MOs visible to an applicant are the public MOs and his/her proposed MO. S/he can only edit her/his own MO.
- All the MOs are visible to the partners, even incomplete applicant-proposed MOs. However, the MOs proposed by applicants who decide to use a public MO instead, are hidden.
- The partners may edit private MOs. They may also duplicate any type of MO. They can also propose new MOs.
- All the public MOs in the 1st cohort have been copied as private MOs in the 2nd cohort.

URGENT CONCERNS/QUESTIONS

- Application begins on Oct 1, until Nov 15
 - Currently only 1 public, 328 private
- MOs should be made public soon (until Oct 20)
 - Mainly work of European partners,
but Asian partners have important role also
- PWs (the application database is not yet ready?)
- Advertisement from APU to get many applicants (10 applicants per available grant)
- How to get more TG3 good applicants?
 - Many possible candidates but have poor basic education
 - Tap former TG3 scholars
 - “get first year univ students”
- TG2 issues
 - Short exchange programs (M11, D18),
how to guarantee credits in their home university
 - Importance of associates
